

Remarks Onboard

June the 2 1838

Came with fine weather wind at S W heading S S E under all sail saw humpback hauled and the sub-board boat struck one & the line parted and lost him & one or on midship mast humped the main S S E & at 4 PM tacked of shore and at 10 PM tacked in shore employed in hoisting the killer so end in the late

Sunday the 3 1-40 S

Came with fine weather heading in shore by the wind S S E under all sail at 4 PM tacked of shore W S W middle & better part with saw nothing so end in the late 1-51 S S E 81-90

Monday the 4

Came with strong trade from S & a S meridian tacked in shore S S E under all sail middle part fine better part saw a schooner & saw black fish hauled and caught & took them to the ship so end in the late 2-20 S S E 81-90

In Port

June the 5 1838

Came with fine weather wind at S W heading S S E under all sail middle part tacked ship to S W better part rather shifted the foretop sail & employed in repairing sails so end in the late 3-10 S S E 80-90 W

Tuesday the 6

Came with fine weather wind at S W heading S S E under all sail middle part fine better part saw a ship cut out the main top & sail & repaired it so end in the late 9-40 S S E 80-90 W

Thursday the 8

Came with fine weather wind at S W heading in shore under all sail at 4 PM hauled the main top & sail at 6 PM tacked of shore at 8 PM spoke a brig better part tacked in shore saw a ship so end in the late 9-50

Friday the 9

Came with strong trade from S W heading S S E under all sail at 4 PM tacked of shore & to in top & sails at 6 PM tacked in shore at 8 tacked of shore W S W Middle and better part with saw nothing so end in the late 9-51 S S E 80-90
