

Remarks Onboard

Sun. the 9 1838

born with fine weather at meridian
tacked ship in shore at 4 PM shifted the
main to sail middle part bearing SE
at meridian tacked of shore at 10 PM
tacked in shore ESE and so ends in the
late 4-105 fms 81-50

Sunday the 10

born with fine weather strong trades from
S steering by the wind & SE under all
sail at 4 PM took in top & sails middle
& latter part the same steering in shore
saw nothing so ends in the late 5-12 S

Monday the 11

fine weather steering in for Bayta after
tacks at 4 PM sent in A boat and
at 6 PM came of brace forward by
the wind S W latter part the same
saw nothing so ends in the late 5-40

Tuesday the 12

born with strong trades from SSE
& steering by the wind S W under all sail
at 4 PM saw black fish caught one
steering by the wind S W middle & latter
part fine vision in the late 8 S

Remarks Onboard

June the 13 1838

fine weather wind at SE steering S W
under all sail at 2 PM saw A Bruch
of the weather beam at 4 PM tacked
ship at 1 PM shortened sail middle part
fine latter part wore ship & stayed W S W
set the courses & so ends in the late 6-10
late 84-100

Wednesday the 14

born with strong trades from SE and steering
W by S under all sail middle part fine
at 4 PM wore ship in shore & SE & saw
black fish so ends in the late 6-00 S
late 84-50

Friday the 15

born with moderate trades from SE and
steering SSE under all sail middle & latter
part fine employed in repairing the main
top sail so ends in the late 4-20 S

Saturday the 16

fine weather wind at SE & steering by the
wind off E under all sail middle part
by A back at daylight brace forward
and at 7 AM wore ship to W S W & at
meridian saw sperm whales lowered &
blased and so ends in the 5-40 2 ships
in sight got 2 whale
