

Remarks Onboard

June 17 1898

born with weather at meridian backed
ship in shore at 4 PM shifted the
main top sail of which Port heading
SE at meridian backed of shore
at 10 AM back in shore ESE &
sailed in the late 4-105 log 81-50

Monday the 18

fine weather steering by the wind
up at 4 PM ~~backed~~ shortened and
made Port wore ship in shore at
day light commenced boiling as and
saw 2 ships late 8-405 log 89-11

Tuesday the 19

born with moderate gale from SE
& steering by the wind E under all
sail & boiling at 4 PM made the
constitutions of the anchor hit 12 mounds
out 1400 miles Port by aback at
day light braces forward by the
wind ESE saw a ship so and in the
late 9-29 log 89-25

Wednesday the 20

born with strong gale from SE and
steering by the wind ESE under short
sail of which Port fire finished boiling
latter Port made all sail wore ship SE
so and in the late 9-25 log 80-40

Remarks Onboard

June 21 1898

born with fine weather steering by the
wind SSW under all sail at 5
PM saw black fish & caught 2 of them
took them to the ship shortened sail middle
Port fine latter Port made all sail
wore ship at 8 AM saw sperm
whales lowered and the starboard Port
caught one at meridian took him
to the ship so and in the late 4-8
log 85-00

Thursday the 22

born with thick weather commenced
putting the whale at 10 AM finished
boiling & braces forward by the wind ESE
under short sail middle Port wore ship
to SSW latter Port commenced boiling
saw a bark to windward so and in
the late 9-405 log 87-50

Friday the 23

born with moderate gale from SE
& thick weather steering by the wind SSW
employed in boiling at 4 PM finished boiling
& wore ship to ESE of which Port fine
latter Port much the same saw black
fish so and in the late 9-42 log 87-20
