

Remarks Onboard

July the 2^d 1838

Left with fine weather at 5 AM sailing by the wind SE wind under all sail saw Cape Blanco & saw fishbacks lowered & the Mast boat struck & the wind parted us west of pointing blood minute past having in shore SE at 8 AM were ship at shore SE & latter part fine comes in the late 4-10 S 4-24

Wednesday the 3

Left with fine weather at 5 AM sailing by the wind SE under all sail at 4 PM lowered after blackfish and the starboard boat caught one and at 6 PM were ship in shore & Middle part fine latter part were ship to SE saw the honey no snow in the late 4-20 S 4-52 4

Thursday the 4

fine weather wind at SE and at meridian saw sperm whales lowered & chased but all in vain were ship to SE latter part with no snow in the late 4-25 S 4-90 4

Thursday the 5

Left with fine weather wind at SE & having SE under all sail at 3 PM were ship in shore & saw black fish so low in the late 4-40 S

On Board

July the 5-1838

Left with fine weather wind at SE & steering by the wind SE under all sail saw blackfish lowered & caught 5 of them took them to the ship and were ship in shore & middle & latter part fine at daylight were ship to SE in the late 5-10 S

Saturday the 7

Left with fine weather wind at SE & steering by the wind SE under all sail saw blackfish lowered & caught one took him to the ship & were ship to SE middle part fine at daylight took ship of shore so low in the late 4-50 S

Sunday the 8

Left with fine weather at meridian took ship in shore SE saw the honey & made her off Bay to shore middle part were ship to SE latter part much the same saw blackfish so low in the late 5-25 S

Monday the 9

Left with moderate gale from SE steering SE at meridian took ship in shore & under all sail middle part were ship to SE latter part with no snow in the late 5-05 S
