July the 10 1838

Commenced with fine weather wind at SSE
 & starting by the wind S.W. under all sail
 at noon we were ship to E middle part
 fine to edw ship to S.W. and at daylight
 took ship in shore E.W. in end in the
 late 8-05

Wednesday the 11

Commenced with fine weather wind at SSE
 starting by the wind E.W. under all sail
 Middle part took ship of shore S.W. &
 at 8 A.M. took in shore E.W. and sail
 in end in the late 8-05

Thursday the 12

fine weather wind at SSE starting by the
 wind E.W. under all sail middle part took
 ship to S.W. & at daylight took ship
 at 8 in end in the late 8-34

Friday the 13

Commenced with fine weather wind at SSE
 & starting by the wind E.W. at 4 P.M.
 took ship S.W. & shore the house
 Middle part took ship better part fine
 in end in the late 8-30

Saturday the 14

Commenced with fine weather wind at SSE
 by the wind E.W. under all sail for
 commencing with the house middle part
 took ship to S.W. better part the same
 in end in the late 8-31 to 8-34

Ship Edward Duval

July the 15 1838

Commenced with moderate gale from SSE
 starting by the wind S.W. under all sail
 fish lowered and caught 300 lb. of
 took them to the ship brace forward
 by the wind. Shook out & took ship
 to S.W. better part the same in end
 in the late 8-30 to 8-34

Monday the 16

Commenced with moderate gale from SSE
 and starting by the wind S.W. under
 all sail middle part took ship the
 same saw fish in end in the
 late 8-30 to 8-34

Tuesday the 17

Commenced with moderate gale from SSE
 & starting by the wind S.W. under
 all sail middle part took in top brace
 better part much the same saw fish
 in end in the late 8-30 to 8-34

Wednesday the 18

Commenced with strong gale from SSE
 and starting by the wind S.W. under
 all sail middle part single reef
 the top sails & strong wind better
 part employed in repairing sails
 in end in the late 9-35 to 9-40
