July the 29 1898

bon with strong gale from SE steering by the wind & SE under single reef top sails middle & latter part of the run nothing seen in the late 11-40 & 50

Monday the 30

bon with strong gale from SE steering by the wind & SE under single reef top sails & saw a bog headed of shore & middle & latter part of the run the main top sail & shifted the fore to main & continued in repairing the main top sail & saw in the late 10-50 & 50

Tuesday the 31

bon with gales from SE & steering by the wind & SE under all sail made fast & the main top sail & sail & the flying jib & saw nothing in the late 10-50 & 50 77-78

August the 1st

bon with moderate gales from SE steering by the wind & SE under all sail & the flying jib middle & latter part of the run the land & the part & saw nothing in the late 10-20 & 50 77-80

Remarks Onboard

August the 2nd 1898

bon with moderate gales from SE steering by the wind & SE under all sail & the American schooner Bine headed at shore & at 8 PM took ship to 77-80 & saw the schooner middle & latter part of the run in the late 10-40 & 50 77-78

Wednesday the 3rd

bon with moderate weather, saw in PM a schooner from Panama bound to all the of SE & took ship of shore middle & latter part of the run in the late 10-40 & 50

Thursday the 4th

bon with fine weather wind at SE & steering by the wind & SE under all sail middle part of the run the land & the part in the late 10-55

Friday the 5th

bon with fine weather wind at SE steering by the wind & SE under all sail middle part of the run the land & the part in the late 11-20 & 50 77-80
