

Remarks On-board

August the 26-1838

Left with light winds from S. steering by the wind S. by W. under all sail. Long by 10 in steering the anchor and made off at last. With sun sperm whales were seen but all in vain as ends

Monday the 27

fine weather wind at S. S. E. steering by the wind S. by W. under all sail at 8 AM. Took ship & took in tops. Sailed at 10 AM. Took fine letter boat on board. The fore sail employed in repairing it is ends in the lat 12-30 S

Tuesday the 28

Left with strong breeze from S. E. and steering by the wind S. by W. under all sail at 8 AM. were seen the S. E. E. middle & bottom last. With sun sperm whales were seen but all in vain as ends in the lat 12-43 S

Wednesday the 29

Left with fine weather wind at S. E. at 2 PM. Sent the fore sail & made all sail steering by the wind S. by W. middle last took ship to S. W. bottom last. The same so ends in the lat 12-50 S by 5 PM

Remarks On-board

August the 30-1838

Left with strong gale from S. E. steering by the wind S. by W. under all sail. Took ship middle last fine letter boat made all sail & took in the starboard last & painted her in the lat 14-33 S by 7 PM

Thursday the 31

Left with moderate gale from S. E. steering by the wind S. by W. under all sail. Took ship & bottom last. The same employed in painting the starboard boat & at 10 AM. were seen sperm whales. Sailed & chased but all in vain as ends in the lat 15-25 S

September the 1

Left with moderate gale from S. E. and steering by the wind S. by W. under all sail at 8 AM. Took ship in top of sails & bottom last. The same employed in painting the starboard boat is ends in the lat 15-40 S by 5 PM

Sunday the 2

Left with moderate gale from S. E. steering by the wind S. by W. under all sail. Took ship middle & bottom last. The same now nothing so ends in the lat 16-49 S by 7 PM
