October the 9 1898

Commenced with moderate gale from NW steering by the wind S E under all sail middle part fine latter part wind to S W & steering S by E & at 11 AM saw the Casapueras bearing E distance 28 miles no sails in the late 34-44

Wednesday the 10

Commenced with moderate gale from NW & steering by the wind S E under all sail at 8 AM wore ship to West & took in two sails & flying jib at 8 AM sent in a boat after wood at meridian took up one boat board 11 ends all well

Thursday the 11

light winds from S employed in working at 5 PM came of with a boat board of wood & an old boat & banded forward by the wind S E & under all sail middle & latter part the same saw San Fernando no sails in the late 33-44 44-54

Friday the 12

light winds from S & steering by the wind S E & under all sail middle & latter part saw San Fernando no sails in the late 33-44 44-54

Saturday the 13

Commenced with light wind from S & steering by the wind S E & under all sail middle part fine latter the same saw nothing no sails in the late 34-44

October the 14-18 1898

Commenced with light wind from S W steering by the wind S E under all sail middle & latter part the same saw nothing no sails in the late 35-44

Sunday the 15

Commenced with moderate gale from NW steering by the wind S E under all sail middle & latter part the same saw nothing no sails in the late 35-44

Monday the 16

strong wind from NW steering S by E under all sail middle & latter part the same saw nothing no sails in the late 37-44 44-54

Tuesday the 17

Commenced with light wind from S W steering S E under all sail middle part fine latter part calm saw nothing no sails in the late 38-44 44-54

Wednesday the 18

Commenced with calm middle & latter part saw San Fernando on board the main sprit & separated it & at meridian sent it 8 AM ends in the late 38-44

Thursday the 19

Commenced with light wind from S E & steering by the wind S under all sail & employed in setting up the main stay
