

Remarks Onboard

October the 29 - 1898

Sea with fine weather wind from S steering
by the wind E-S-E until 10 AM light fog
I saw eight whale houses but all in
vain at 7 PM shortened sail were ship to S-S-E
until 10 PM the same latter were ship E-S-E
saw eight whale houses but all in vain
saw in the boat 42-47 S

Tuesday the 30th

fine weather wind at S & steering spinn
whale at dusk came onboard & by aback
heading W-S-W middle part fine latter
part employed in chasing whale in the
boat 41-50 S

Wednesday the 31

fine weather employed in chasing whale & the
harbour boat struck me & got stove took
her in at 5 PM the worst boat struck
& at dusk set the whale spouting thick
fog we by aback heading S-W latter part
dotted at 10 PM saw a whale house &
the worst boat struck & got stove took
her in to the ship no end in the boat 40-42 S

In the Coast of Chile

November the 1 - 1898

fine weather commenced cutting at 9 AM finished
by shortened sail & spoke the horse of horse
1500 lbs of whale oil middle part fine latter
part commenced fishing no end in the boat
42-01 S

Thursday the 2

fine weather wind at N & steering by the
wind E-N-E under all sail the head in sight
& at 4 PM saw eight whale houses but
all in vain at dusk shortened sail & steered
S-S-W middle & latter part when at meridian
finished cutting & employed in repairing a boat
in the boat 41-54 S

Friday the 3rd

light wind from S-W & steering by the wind
& after midnight whale got under shortened sail
& spoke the same Warren 700 lbs middle
& latter part calm & repairing boats & saw
the same got a small whale to day no end
in the boat 42-11 S fog 4-48 W

Saturday the 4th

light wind from S-S-E & steering by the wind
S-W at 6 PM double reefed the top sail
middle & latter part the same no end
in the boat 42-05 S
