December the 14 - 1838

Commenced with light winds from off shore with squalls of rain middle part much the same latter part clear employed in cleaning the ship & mending the boards so and in the Port of Tetea means

Saturday the 15

Commenced with fine & breeze the sails to dry then employed in breaking out the main hatch way & other small jobs middle part strong winds from the North employed in mending the ship so and

Sunday the 16

fine & pleasant weather middle part with latter part one watch on shore & the mate came down with anchors so and in port yet

Monday the 17

fine & pleasant weather employed in sending the anchors on shore that we hired & replacing ours & mending middle & latter part little so and

Tuesday the 18

Commenced with fine weather employed in mending middle part & raising latter part the same one watch on shore so and

Wednesday the 19

Commenced with rainy weather one watch on shore middle & latter part the same so and in port yet

December the 20 - 1838

Commenced with rainy weather one watch on shore middle part fine latter part the same employed in mending the ship so and all well yet

Friday the 21

Commenced with strong winds from S & fine weather employed in painting the ship middle part fine latter part much the same so and in port yet

Saturday the 22

Commenced with fine weather employed in painting at meridian finished so and in port yet

Sunday the 23

Commenced with fine weather employed in painting & mending & stowing down water middle part fine latter part raising so and one watch on shore

Monday the 24

Commenced with rainy weather middle part with latter part fine employed in stowing down water so and in port

Tuesday the 25

Commenced with fine weather middle part with latter part the same so and in

Wednesday the 26

Commenced with fine weather middle part with latter part employed in painting the ship so and in port
