December the 27-1898

Commenced with fine weather middle & latter part ditto no ends in port yet

Friday the 28

Commenced with fine weather middle & latter part ditto ship all ready for sea and

Saturday the 29

Commenced with fine weather wind at 8 AM 2 PM have started out under way & stood out the bay at Takahama at 4 PM double reefed the topsails & stored N.W. by 10 middle & latter part strong gale no ends in the

Sunday the 30

Comm. with strong gale from south of meridian were ship to 8 AM heavy sea running at 1 PM reefed the main boom under & store her for the crew was ship & hoisted about 8 toward her along side & took her in on deck at 6 PM took in the fore house sail heading 8 middle part the same latter part made sail no ends in the lat 33-51 S

Monday the 31

Comm. with strong gale from S & steering N.E. saw the land & at 6 PM shore land sail middle part calm in the port wind at 11 AM ship the fore topsails & no ends in the lat 29-10 S



Remarks Onboard

January the 1-1899

Commenced with fine weather middle & latter part calm employed in ships duty rain throughout no ends in the lat 33-29 S

Tuesday the 2

Comm. with light winds from S steering S.W. by under all sail at 6 AM took in the light sail of fore top of 10 foresails with the main yard aback middle & latter part calm at 4 PM sent about no ends in

Wednesday the 3

Comm. with fine weather boat on shore at 8 AM the boat came off brace forward by the wind N.W. by middle & latter part calm employed in ships duty no ends lat 32-49

Thursday the 4

Comm. with at 4 PM took on light wind from S & steered N.W. by under all sail middle & latter part ditto saw blackbird employed in repairing at boat no ends in the lat 31-29 S

Friday the 5

Comm. with strong winds from S.E. & steering N.W. by at 4 PM double reefed the topsails & middle part the same latter part made all sail saw nothing no ends in the lat 29-00 S
