January the 16- 1839

Came with fine pleasant weather moderate & latter the same one watch on shore & the mate came down with the anchors no ends in front yet

Monday the 17

Came with fine weather employed in raising the anchors ashore we borrowed 4 exploring and watering 80 middle & latter part calm

Tuesday the 18

Came with fine weather employed in watering middle part rainy latter the same one watch on shore as wind

Wednesday the 19

Came with rainy weather one watch on shore middle & latter part the same no ends in front yet

Thursday the 20

Came with rainy weather one watch on shore middle part fine latter part the same employed in painting the ship out side red and brass on board

Friday the 21

Came with strong gales from south & employed in painting the ship middle part fine latter part the same no ends in front yet

Remarks Onboard

January the 22 1839

Came with fine weather from at S.E. & steering by the wind S.W. under all sail middle latter part fine latter part saw nothing in the sea no ends in the hold at 1-35 S.W. 77-70 3/4

Wednesday the 23

Came with fine weather from at S.E. & steering by the wind S.W. under all sail middle latter part fine latter part saw nothing in the sea no ends in the hold at 1-47 S.W. 78 3/4

Thursday the 24

Came with fine weather steering by the wind S.W. under all sail middle & latter part calm saw nothing employed in repairing the ship no ends in the hold at 2-12 S.W. 80-17 3/4

Friday the 25

Came with light wind from S.E. & steering by the wind S.W. under all sail finished the sparker & bent it middle & latter part calm employed in repairing sails no ends in the hold at 2-28 S.W.

Saturday the 26

Came with light wind from S.E. & steering by the wind S.W. under all sail middle & latter part calm saw nothing no ends in the hold at 2-35 S.W. 80 3/4
