February the 15-1899

born with light wind from S & steering  
S by E & under all sail at 4 PM. set  
the fore topmast shrouding sail and the  
V-bottle mast with no nothing sails in  
the late 48-52 S by E 51-18

Sunday the 17

born with wind from N & steering S by E &  
under all drawing sail middle & latter part  
strong gale from N by E & light showers of rain  
at 10 AM to in the standing sail & double  
reef. The topmast now nothing so much in  
the late 41-25 S by E 81-25

Monday the 18

born with strong gale from N by E steering  
S by E & under all drawing sail middle &  
latter part much the same now nothing  
so much in the late 41-25 S by E 81-25

Tuesday the 19

born with strong gale from N & steering  
S by E & under all drawing sail at 2 PM  
wind hauled to W since 6 point strong gale  
back in the fore & main topmast & close  
reef. The main latter part more moderate  
more all sail so much in the late 45-51 S  
by E 80-55

Wednesday the 20

born with light from S W by S & steering  
S by E under all sail middle and latter part  
latter now nothing so much in the late 48-52 S by E 80-55

# Bounce Home Home

February the 21-1899

born with light wind from S by E and steering  
by the wind S & under all sail middle part  
strong gale took in fore & main topmast &  
single reef. The topmast latter part the same  
now nothing so much in the late 48-52 S by E 81-18

Friday the 22

born with light wind from S & steering by  
the wind S by E under all drawing sail at 2 PM  
were ship to S & middle part the same latter part  
were at W & steering S & under all drawing sail  
now nothing so much in the late 48-52 S by E 80-55

Saturday the 23

born with strong gale from W & steering S & E  
under all drawing sail middle part took in  
the main topmast & single reef. The topmast  
latter part more moderate more all sail & set  
the fore topmast shrouding sail & now nothing  
so much in the late 52-30 S by E 80-55

Sunday the 25

born with light wind & foggy from W  
& steering S & E under all sail middle & latter part  
much the same so much in the late 48-52 S by E 80-55

Monday the 26

born with light from N by E & steering S & E  
under all drawing sail took in the standing sail  
and double reef. The topmast middle part set  
the main topmast & the fore topmast  
standing sail latter part now nothing  
so much in the late 50-30 S by E 45-49 W
