- 11th Friday morning cloudy with light breeze from the Eastward. Laying to sea are busily employed trying out the lead cutting up the head in the afternoon we had some rain we finished trying out the headwood log on the ship with the water blade and float and
- 12th Saturday morning fair and pleasant with light breeze from the N.E. Laying to sea are busily employed trying out the water at sea we finished trying out the water turned out by barrels.
- 13th Sunday morning fair and pleasant with strong breeze from the N.E. Steering S by S we made sail.
- 14th Monday morning fair and pleasant with strong breeze from the Eastward steering to the north we finished the main top gallant sail.
- 15th Tuesday morning commence with light breeze from the N.E. steering to the southward accompanied with rain and a heavy sea running.
- 16th Wednesday morning commence with light breeze from the Eastward accompanied with rain steering to the southward and Eastward.
- 17th Thursday morning fair and pleasant with light breeze from the Eastward standing on the rain we are busily employed beating out and storing down the bit sea we are out finished all.
- 18th Friday morning fair and pleasant with light breeze from the N.E. steering on the rain with a hail in light we are busily storing down our hole out & leaks of bit and copper then over again in the afternoon we finish storing down and close up the bit with a bit of our main top.
