August 30th Friday morning fair and pleasant with light breeze from the Eastward Steering S.W. in the afternoon we were ship Steering S.W. we are busy setting the rig and finish and set the rig Latitude 31-56-30

31st Saturday morning fair and pleasant with light breeze from the Eastward Steering N.N.E. with all sail and a sail in sight Latitude Longitude

Sept 1st Sunday morning fair and pleasant with light breeze from the Eastward Steering on the wind in the afternoon the weather still fair and pleasant Steering S.W. Latitude Longitude

2^d Monday morning fair and pleasant with strong breeze from the Eastward Steering N.W. by E. in the afternoon we tacked ship Steering S.W. Latitude Longitude

3^d Tuesday morning fair and pleasant with light breeze from the Eastward Steering S.W. we raise a sail ahead and we have land in sight here and there the place to be the white Oregon Dunes of N. Lat. 32-22 South. We saw the Captain went on board to stay all day and then we pulled away again going in company and after supper we have drunk the midnight and landed down the boat and went after the Captain Latitude 32-24 N Longitude 179-14 East

slight breeze from the Eastward laying the under short sail all hands busily employed trying out the boiler and the Copper is busy setting up shrouds to put out for us are flush for Casks Latitude Longitude

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Sept 4th Wednesday morning fair and pleasant with light breeze from the Eastward Steering N.E. with all sail and the Dancer in sight Sisters in the afternoon the still fine and pleasant Latitude 33-40 N Longitude 178-33 E

5th Thursday morning fair and pleasant with light breeze from the S.W. Steering S.W. with the Dancer still in sight we saw some porpoises Latitude 34-1 N Longitude 179-22 W

6th Friday morning fair and pleasant with light breeze from the S.W. Steering S.W. with the Dancer in sight we went to mend it in the afternoon we found and bent it again with the weather still fine and pleasant we saw some porpoises Latitude 34-28 N Longitude 178-54 W

7th Saturday morning fair and pleasant with light breeze from the Westward Steering S.W. with all sail we are bound for the Sandwich Islands we are busy with mending the foremast in the afternoon we saw two Large Buoys Latitude 33-26 N Longitude 177-15 W

8th Sunday morning fair and pleasant with light breeze from the Westward Steering S.W. with all sail in the afternoon the weather cloudy with light rains Latitude 32-36 N Longitude 176-28 W

in the afternoon we caught up and the lee rope of the main sail parted and we unrent it and mended it and bent it again and furlled it and reefed the topsail and the rig Latitude 31-23 S Longitude 176-31 W Longitude 177-46 W
