November 3^d Sunday morning fair and pleasant with light
breezes from the S.E. steering on the wind with all sail
Latitude 4 = 49. S.

4th Monday morning fair and pleasant with light
breezes from the S.E. steering on the wind we are
employed mending the fore top sail
Latitude 6 = 55. S.

5th Tuesday morning fair and pleasant with light
breezes from the N.E. steering S.E. in the afternoon
we finished mending the fore top sail and set the
fore topmast standing sail
Latitude 8 = 59. S. Longitude 156 = 32. W.

6th Wednesday morning fair and pleasant with light
breezes from the N.E. steering S.E. under all sail
and busy receiving new maintopgallant braces
Latitude 9 = 57. S.

7th Thursday morning fair and pleasant with light
breezes from the N.E. steering S.E. we unlent the
main sail in the afternoon the hauler to N.E.
Latitude 11 = 07. S.

8th Friday morning fair and pleasant with light breezes
from the S.E. steering on the wind with all sail
Latitude 12 = 55. S.

9th Saturday morning fair and pleasant with
light breezes from the S.E. steering on the
wind with all sail
Latitude 13 = 50. S.

10th Sunday morning fair and pleasant with light
breezes from the S.E. steering on the wind with all sail
under short sail all hands busily employed
