6th Friday morning commences with strong winds from the S.W. Steering E. by S. with a heavy sea running we furl the foretopgallant sail and get Lat. by Obs $43^{\circ}55'S$ D.R. $43^{\circ}53'S$ Longitude by D.R. $117^{\circ}22'W$

7th Saturday morning commences with breeze from the S.W. Steering E. by S. with a heavy sea running Latitude by Obs $43^{\circ}37'S$ D.R. $43^{\circ}38'S$ Longitude by D.R. $113^{\circ}06'W$

8th Sunday morning commences with strong breeze from the S.W. Steering E. by S. in the afternoon the weather fair and pleasant we have a preventive and apply the hose again and take the foretopmast studding sail we have some heavy squalls and light rain we have a heavy sea running Latitude by Obs $44^{\circ}27'S$ D.R. $44^{\circ}28'S$ Longitude by D.R. $110^{\circ}34'W$
