

Remarks on the board Bark Bertha

Friday

June 23rd 1911 p.m. Calm at 5 a.m. we saw a school of whals drop down boats Mr. Brown struck one came board cutting and started to try out. Several steamers past by and gaming with schooner T. Towner end of day. Lat: 36.40 Lon: 73.39

Saturday

June 24th 1911 p.m. light breeze from SW and thick fog at 4 p.m. Captain saw school of whals from the house with full masthead. Lower down the boats second boat struck one. Schooner T. Towner in sight end of day. no observation

Sunday

June 25th 1911 p.m. light breeze and hazy weather wind from SW all sails set watch employed try out. at 4 p.m. Thaddeus Martin saw school of whals and drops down the boats Mr. Brown struck one iron came out Mr. Almada struck one. Schooner T. Towner was in sight. lots steamers by end of day Lat: 36.48 no longitude

Monday

June 26th 1911 day began with squally with rain cutting the whal and make sails p.m. fresh breeze from SW employ try out and stowed down some sail. Saw nothing at 7 clock short her down to low topsails wore ship to westward tack. end of day Lat: 36.55 N Lon: 73.24 W

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Tuesday

June 27th 1911 p.m. light breeze and fine weather wind from SW all sails set. at 8 a.m. we saw schooner Nickson chasing whals but she have get any and we gave up. employed finish stowed down the oil 160 bars. at 7 clock short her down and let stowed to NW tack end of day. Lat: 37.10 N Lon: 73.17 W

Wednesday

June 28th 1911 p.m. light breeze from W and hazy weather at 5:30 Antonio Snarres saw a school of whals and we drop down the boats and we got three whals Mr. Brown one Mr. Almada one Mr. Goncalves one schooner Nickson got 2 and get his boat stove came board cutting the whals. at 6 p.m. Captain went board of a m. Nicholson end of day. Lat: 37.00 N Lon: 73.09 W

Thursday

June 29th 1911 p.m. fresh breeze and hazy weather wind from N all sails set watch employed try out. at 7 clock short her down on lower topsails wore ship to NW ward tack. Several vessels and steamers in sight. end of day. Lat: 36.46 N Lon: 73.54 W

Friday

June 30th 1911 p.m. light breeze and hazy weather wind from N all sails set. saw three whaling and we gaming with a m. Nicholson and groger two of them got whals to day. employed finish stowed down 37 bars. end of day Lat: 36.28 N Lon: 73.45 W
