Tuesday

July 18th 1911 p.m. steady breezes and hazy weather
wind from N all sails set saw lots vessels
and steamers watch employed on ship duty
at 7 clock short her down to low topsails
and let her lay. end of day.

Wednesday

July 19th 1911
p.m. light breezes and fine clear weather wind from
NE all sails set. watch employed on ship duty
saw several steamers and vessels and we
spoke to steamer Taff send some letters
home gaming with J. Turner. at 7 clock
short her down to low topsails. end of day
Lat: 36.39 N Lon: 74.08 W

Thursday

July 20th 1911 p.m. light breezes and fine clear weather
wind from SW all sails set at 4 a.m.
we saw J. Turner with her boats down
and we drop down our boats third mate
struck one whale his line and first
mate got one whale J. Turner got one
and other schooner one came aboard
cutting the whale and send down gears
lots steamers and vessels in sight
end of day. Lat: 36.31 N Lon: 74.17 W

Friday

July 21st 1911
p.m. fresh breezes and cloudy weather wind
from SW ship on short sails employed
hunting several vessels in sight and
steamers. spoke with schooner Wayland
end of day. Lat: 36.36 N Lon: 74.23 W

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Saturday

July 22nd 1911 p.m. fresh breezes from N all sails
set employed stowed down 20 barrels of oil
and gaming with schooner Carlton Bell
and Nicholson 3 ~~take~~ take 2 1/2 barrels of coal
several vessels and steamer on sight
end of day. Lat: 36.40 N Lon: 74.09 W

Sunday

July 23th 1911
p.m. fresh breezes from N all sails set
watch employed on ship duty. lots vessels
and steamers in our company. at 7 clock
short her down to low topsails let her
end of day. Lat: 36.39 N Lon: 74.22 W

Monday

July 24th 1911
p.m. strong breezes and high sea (wind from SW)
ships on short sails watch employed repairing
sail. two vessels and steamer in sight
pumps carefully intended vessel shipping much
water on deck button up every thing round
end of day. Lat: 36.45 N Lon: 74.03 W

Tuesday

July 25th 1911 p.m. fine clear weather all sails
set at 11 clock channel closes saw a school
of whales and we drop down the boats
Meri Brown struck one Meri Almada one
Meri Juncalas one Meri Viera one
on Lat: 36.28 N Lon: 73.56 W end of day
