July 26<sup>th</sup> 1911 p.m. light breeze from NE and clear weather employed cutting the whale and started to try out - 6 vessels and steamers in sight gaining with Schooner Nicholson and I take 2 barrels of coal from him. end of day. Lat: 36.34 N Lon: 73.49 W

Thursday

July 27<sup>th</sup> 1911 p.m. fresh breeze and cloudy weather wind from NE all sails set employed try out and allowed down some oil several vessels and steamers in our company. I and we gaining with Schooner Wayland. at 7 clock short her down to low topsails. end of day. Lat: 36.30 N Lon: 74.05 W

Friday

July 28<sup>th</sup> 1911 p.m. calm all day and big swell from SE and cloudy weather employed allowed down oil 66 barrel lots vessels and steamers in sight and we gaining with Schooner J. Towner. end of day. Lat: 36.37 N Lon: 74.06 W

Saturday

July 29<sup>th</sup> 1911 p.m. light breeze from NE all sails set and fine clear weather watch employed on ship's duty. several vessels and steamers in sight gaining with Schooner J. Towner and gracier end of day. Lat: 36.28 N Lon: 74.18 W

Sunday

July 30<sup>th</sup> 1911 p.m. calm and fine clear weather ~~and from~~ several vessels in sight and steamers gaining with Schooner A. Nicholson and J. Towner end of day. Lat: 36.31 N Lon: 74.02 W

Monday

July 31<sup>st</sup> 1911 p.m. calm and clear weather all sails set watch employed far down the riggings saw 4 Schooners and steamers end of day. Lat: 36.40 N Lon: 73.42 W

Tuesday

August 1<sup>st</sup> 1911

p.m. light breeze and fine clear weather wind from E all sails set. watch employed tarring and scraping masts saw lots vessels and steamers. at 7 clock short her down to low topsails let lay. end of day. Lat: 36.46 N Lon: 73.51 W

Wednesday

August 2<sup>nd</sup> 1911 p.m. light breeze and fine clear weather wind from SE all sails set watch employed scraping iron work and painting them saw several steamers and a vessel. at 7 clock short her down to low topsails end of day. Lat: 37.09 N Lon: 73.53 W

Thursday

August 3<sup>rd</sup> 1911 p.m. light breeze and fine weather wind from E all sails set watch employed painting iron work. saw lots steamers and a vessel. at 7 clock taking on light sails. and wore ship to the northward end of day. Lat: 36.42 N Lon: 73.53 W

Friday

August 4<sup>th</sup> 1911 p.m. calm and fine weather all sails set watch employed on ship's duty saw nothing but steamers at 7 clock taking on light sails. end of day. Lat: 36.42 N Lon: 73.57 W
