Monday 30th Octr 1843

Strong gales from the South West throughout this day a large sea running got a very heavy press of sail on the ship to day in fact every stitch of canvas that will draw at all is on her the foremast and main on at both bottom in a shocking precarious state working from side to side

Tuesday 31. Octr

This day commenced with strong breezes middle and latter part very light air the wind very variable from South to West clear pleasant weather throughout

Light breezes and clear pleasant weather throughout this day the winds very variable from South to West South West

Moderate weather and light breezes from the South West latter part the wind shifted to South and continued very light

Calm through the first and middle part latter a light breeze sprung up from the North West and lasted throughout

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Saturday 4th Novr 1843

Clear weather and light breezes from the North West to South West latter part the sky is over cast and has all the appearance of an approaching storm very moderate warm weather for a few days past

Sunday 5 Novr

Calm for the first part middle and latter part light breezes with heavy cloudy weather

Light breezes heavy cloudy weather throughout this day the watch doing several small jobs aloft a number on the men sick with boils and other sicknesses

Light breezes for the first part middle and latter strong breezes from the South and westward thick cloudy weather

Light air for the first part middle and latter strong breezes but very baffling from South to South West at 10h AM took in the studding sails and main royal braced sharp up on the wind
