Clear pleasant weather with light breeze at day light Fayall dist 6 leagues bearing South at 11 h AM the Capt and Mate went on shore at 8 h PM the Capt returned shiped four Porbeagles and one American making 30 men in all on board at 12 h squared away from Fayall

Clear weather with light winds saw several ships arising round the islands the watch employed sorting the onions and drying them so ends this day

First part cloudy middle and latter clear pleasant weather the watch warriously employed in ships duty Carpenter repairing the boat Cooper making buckets blacksmith at work also
