Saturday 13 July 1844

Strong breeze throughout this day with clear weather the watch variously employed painting the bow boat two sails in sight

Cloudy weather and blowing strong breeze throughout this day two sails in sight one standing to the West the other to the S S W

Clear pleasant weather with moderate breezes from the North East made the Island of St Antonio bearing south per compass dist 30 miles

Hazy weather throughout this day the watch variously employed in ships duty nothing in sight to day

Wednesday 17 July

Clear weather with a light breeze steering for the Island of St Nicholas made the Island at 3 h PM ran down to the East end and luffed the ship to the wind of shore one league flogged the steward for stealing rum at 11 h AM sent the boat on shore with the mate to trade

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Thursday 17 July 1844

Lying off and on the land the boat on shore trading got on board 7 hogs fowl and bananas

Friday 18 July

Lying off and on the Island the boat on shore trading very light winds from the south with clear pleasant weather

Saturday 19 July

Light airs and calms at 2 h PM all on board made sail from the Island steering S W saw a whale barge bound in towards the Island

Sunday 20 July

Light winds for the most part at 5 h PM made the Island of Brava distant of shore one league saw four ships at noon standing to the South
