Sunday 2 Aug 1844

Clear pleasant weather with light breezes for the first part middle and latter strong breezes one schooner in sight showed her colours but could not make them out.

Monday 3 August

Clear pleasant weather with light breezes the watch variously employed

Tuesday 4 August

Clear weather with strong South East trades the watch variously employed in ships duty

Wednesday 5 August

Cloudy weather with strong gales and rain the same throughout the day

Thursday 6 August

Thick weather and squally through this day several sails in sight standing to the south

Friday 7 August

Rainy and heavy squalls through the most part of this day two sails in sight standing to the south

Saturday 8 August

Clear weather with light breezes from the South East the watch employed tarring down the rigging

Sunday 9 August

Clear pleasant weather with moderate breezes through out this day

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Monday 10 August 1844

Clear pleasant weather with strong South East trade winds employed tarring the rigging and painting a boat

Tuesday 11 Aug

Clear weather with strong breezes throughout this day several iron backs in sight

Wednesday 12 Aug

Clear weather and pleasant breezes through this day the watch variously employed in ships duty

Thursday 13 Aug

Clear pleasant weather with light breezes from the South East the watch variously employed two sails in sight

Friday 14 August

Cloudy weather with heavy squalls through the most part wind from S E to E

Saturday 15 August

Clear pleasant weather with strong breezes throughout the watch picking over Potatoes

Sunday 16 Aug

First and middle part squally latter clear weather with strong breezes spoke the Barque Bertra Con Stranland 48 days from London her Log differing from ours 6° 25' m

Strong breezes with cloudy weather throughout wrought a purpose the watch employed pulling spun yarn
