Friday 5 Sep

Blowing strong gales from the South throughout this day saw two fin backs thick and foggy the Capt. repairing a boat
Courses Winds Latt Long
E to E South 41° 44' 168° 40' 11

Saturday 6 Sep

Blowing strong breezes throughout this day with thick fog and rain caught a porpoise

E to E South 40° 8' 166 43

Sunday 7 Sep

Moderate breezes throughout this day have away schooner and all the day the nothing in sight whatever still call this day

Monday 8 Sep

Baffling winds throughout carried away the deadeye bolt of the main stay and down it came on deck the mate and black smith welded it to gether again and had it secured latter part employed clearing up between decks

Tuesday 9 Sep

Light breezes throughout this day employed filling the rigging nothing in sight whatever

Mostly calm throughout fitting the rigging

Thursday 11 Sep

Calm throughout this day employed filling the rigging and tarring down nothing in sight whatever

Friday 12 Sep

Calm for the most part of this day employed fitting the rigging and tarring down

Saturday 13 Sep

Blowing strong gales throughout this day with rain employed washing ship

Sunday 14 Sep

Blowing strong gales throughout at 5 PM spoke the ship Inezgama bound to the Sandwich Islands at 12 PM carried away the fore topmast studding sail all sail set and blowing salt water most handsomely

Monday 15 Sep

Blowing fresh gales throughout this day light showers of rain two sails in sight repairing the top mast studding sail and seraping the tar of the yards and masts
