 29.00 Slight & hail Middle part light  
 29.00 breeze from that and cloudy rather  
 29.00 part strong breeze from that with  
 Main 29.00 snow squalls. Course 57.12 78.25  
 Th 102 on deck

Friday May 16th Commenced with brisk westerly  
 breeze and clouds with snow squalls  
 29.98 Middle part much the same  
 28.98 latter part brisk breeze from N.W.  
 29.98 and cloudy heading by the wind East S.W.

 29.25 latter part from South and increased  
 Th 40 got up a lower & maintop maststeeple  
 sail and mainmast course 54.15 55.30

Wednesday May 21st Commenced with moderate southerly  
 breeze and increased sent up the Mizzenmast  
 29.20 lant & Middle part from S.W. that  
 29.20 and thick weather latter part hauld  
 29.25 to S.W. that 53.35 55.50  
 29.25

Thursday May 22nd Brisk breeze from that and cloudy  
 Middle part squally latter part hauld  
 29.30 to S.W. with strong breeze and cloudy  
 40 course S.W. that 50.40 by 52.40

Friday May 23rd These 24 hours commenced with strong
