 Mon 29.50 light and light shortly with 9 PM the wind
 the 53 came swarming past BB 41 in heavy
 part lantern squall and in with the storm
 until 10 o'clock blew away the mainmast and yard
 also the foremast to the foremast yard at the top sail as far
 up as the close reef and down some other sails at quarter
 part 10 the barometer at 29.80 and rising the gale was then
 moderating
