November the 25
This Day Comences with fine weather
And a fine breeze from the N. N. W.
a Steering S. E. all hands employed
in Ships Duty latter part rain & gales
And so ends this 24 ours

November the 26
This Day we have fine weather Ship
a heading S. di E. wind rather light
All hands imployed in Ships Duty
So ends this Day

November the 27 1851
This Day we have Calm the fore part
Brok out the fore hatch for the tops
and a foresail and fitted them to
Sailed later part a light breeze from the
S. E. Steering S. di E. Ends this 24 ours
Sat. 29. 19

November the 28 Friday
This Day Comences with thick weather
and mudd part rainy and so ends
this

Saturday November the 29
This Day comences with a strong
Breeze from the S. S. W. a heading
S. W. and so ends this 24 ours

Sunday the 30 November
This Day we have a head wind and a
heavy wind a Ship in sight at 1.0
Spoke her and gamed with her it
Was the Ship Navigator of fair haven
Bound to the arctic ocean
