

February the 12th 1852

Tuesday the 12th this morning we hove
up our anchor and put to sea and
we bid that was good day we got our
Anchors on the Bow once more and we
steered on the wind & day so ends this

Wednesday the 14th of February
this Day we have fine weather and a
fine Breeze from the N a steering
on the wind into the S & a large quantity
of fish Backs in Lot and pump Backs
Latent Long

Thursday the 15th of January
this Day we have it thick and rainy
Ship under Dudel reef top sails a heading
& the weather no better and so ends

Monday the 16th of January 1852
this Day begins with a light Breeze
from the W a steering N & at
6 P M turned out our Reefs and
steered E N E and at 2 P M took
in sail and close reefed the main topsail
and have our ship too with a heavy gale of
wind from the S and so ends

Tuesday the 17th of January
this morning we made sail and steering
N E strong Breezes from the W
sent up the main top galant yard
so ends this Lat 46 00 Long 149 21 E

Wednesday the 18th of January
this Day we have a strong breeze from the N W
steering E by N this morning we saw several
Whales round our Boat but they was a gang so
fast that we could not get hold
Lat 46 12 Long 177 22 W

On Board of the Ship Wm. Tell 1852

Thursday the 19th of January
this Day we have a gale of wind from
the W a steering N E under
Dudel reef top sails the gale still
continuous Lat 46 11 S Long 173 00 W

Friday the 20th of January
this Day commences with a strong Breeze from
the S W a steering N E later part
Mist all sail the weather fine so ends
Lat 44 56 S Long 170 22 W

Saturday the 21st of January
this Day we have fine weather and a light
Breeze from the W a steering N E
A mentioning the Captains Bat this Day ends
Lat 43 12 Long 168 50 W

Sunday the 23rd of February
this Day we have fine weather and a light
Breeze from the W a steering N E
this Day we got our Black Smith
forged up and on dent the fore sail
and dent the olivine gone and so ends
Lat 42 Long

Tuesday the 24th of February 1852
this Day we have a light Breeze from the N N E
Ship on the wind a heading N W
later part took in top galant sails then
Weather thick and rainy and so ends this Day
Lat 42 Long

Wednesday the 26th of February 1852
this Day commences with a gale of
wind Ship under Dudel reef top sails
the weather thick and rainy the
Wind from the N and W a steering
N E strong gale so ends this
Wm. Betsey & Thos. at home
with pleasure at home
