Thursday the 25 of February
This Day we have fine weather and a light
Breeze from the S and W steering N by E
all hands are employed in mending the
fore topsail and looms this Day
Lat 21. 8 Long 161. 60

Friday the 26 of February 1862
This Day commences with a light breeze from
the S E a steering N E by N lat
Part the wind strong took in fore and main
top galleysails and mended the old four topsail
Lat 23. 16 Long 161. 16

Saturday the 27 of February
This Day we have a strong breeze from the S E
a steering N Lat 31. 01 Long 161. 16

Sunday the 28 of February 1862
This is the last day of this month four part
rally lat part the weather fine and pleasant
Calm a ship in sight a boat 10 miles
Distant Lat 29. 8 Long 161. 16

Monday the 1 March

This Day we have fine weather and
a light breeze from the S E with fine
a ship in sight we spoke her it
was the ship Dover of New London
Captain Havens and we gave her the salute
Lat 28. 12

Tuesday the 2 of March
This Day we have fine weather and a light
Breeze from the S E a steering N on the
Wind and we gave her the salute this Day

Wednesday the 3 of March
This Day we have fine weather the wind
from the S E a ship a heaving N

Thursday the 4 of March 1862

This Day we have fine weather and a fine
Breeze from the S E a steering N
And a cabin boy died at 4 P M
and buried him at 9 o'clock in the morning
his Name was James Morgan
Lat 21. 8 Long 161. 60

Friday the 5 of March
This Day we have fine weather and a light
Breeze from the S E a steering N E
a gaming with the Dover of New London
Looms these 2 & ours
Lat 21. 8 Long 161. 60

Saturday the 6 of March
This Day we have fine weather and a
light Breeze from the S and E a steering
N by E the land in sight the
Boats from both ships were sent and went
a shore the Dovers boats landed and got
a good mess of coconuts and our boats
could not find the proper place
got nothing Looms this Day
Lat 18. 04 Long 163. 10

Sunday the 7 of March
This Day we have a light breeze
from the S E to the N W
Shipped overboard Sails a
steering N by E Looms this
Lat 17. 27 Long 163. 03

Monday the 8 of March
This Day we have light and Batten
winds employed in mending old
rigger and mending chafes Looms

Tuesday the 9 of March
This Day we have it calm and
rally a let up in our topmast
rigger and top galleysails
Looms this Day
