we set up the main rigger and the main  
topmost Rigger and soens this Day

Sunday the 14 of March  
This Day we have fine pleasant weather  
and a light breeze from the S and E  
a steering N W soens this fine  
Sunday Lat 26 Long 167 1/2

Monday the 15 of March  
This Day we have fine weather and a  
light breeze from the S E a steering  
N N W all hands to mend the main  
top sail and at 5 dent it a gale soens

Tuesday the 16 of March  
This Day we have fine pleasant weather  
a steering N W the watch  
imployed in taking down the rigger  
soens this 24 ours

Wednesday the 17 of March 1852  
This Day we have a fine breeze from the  
S E a steering N W saw  
thing in sight and soens this 24 ours

Thursday the 18 of March  
This Day we have fine weather and a  
light breeze from the E a steering  
N W by N a fitting a new boat  
soens this Lat Long

Friday the 19 of March  
This Day we have fine weather and  
a fine breeze from the S E a steering  
N W by W half W the land  
in sight Gardner's island  
and soens this Lat 2.05 Long 1

Saturday the 20 of March 1852  
This Day we have fine weather and  
a fine breeze from the N E a steering  
N N W we saw nothing  
Lat 3.05 Long 173.59

Sunday the 21 of March  
This Day we have fine weather and  
a fine breeze from the S E a steering  
N N W saw a Ship Atlantic  
of Nantucket 20 months out with  
9 hundred and 50 barrels of Spum  
Oil Lat 5 E S Long 177.00

Monday the 22 of March  
This Day we have fine weather and  
a fine breeze from the S E a steering  
N W saw new thing this Day

Tuesday the 23 of March  
This Day as the same as yesterday  
commenced making a fore top galent sail  
out of a fore Stiver sail soens
