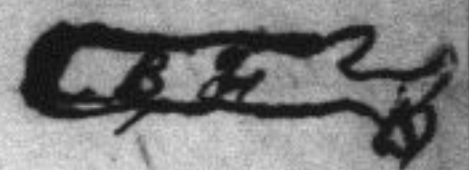


Continued on Board of the S. Wm Tell

Wednesday the 24 of March 1852

This Day we have thick and rain
Squalls the wind Baffin a Steering
N. W. Saw Black fish this
Morning and sent this Day 

Thursday the 25 of March 1852

This Day we have fine weather and a fine
Breeze from the S. and E. a Steering N. W.
Loens Lat 71.13 Long 117.51 43 East

Friday the 26 of March
This Day we have fine weather and a
fine Breeze from the S. E. a
Steering W. by W. this morning
We ordered the mantsail and mended it
and sent it a gane and Loens this Day

Saturday the 27 of March
This is a fine Day and a fine
Strong Breeze from the S. E. a Steering
N. W. by W. we saw nothing this Day
Latent heat 11.20

Sunday the 28 of March
The forepart of this Day we have
Squall and sun rain the wind from
the N. E. a Steering N. W. by W.
we on Bent the Sprinker and mended it
and sent it a gane and Loens
Lat 13.20 N. Long 171.58 East

Monday the 29 of March
This Day we have fine weather and a
fine Breeze from the N. E. a Steering
N. W. we Broak out the Sterly
hatch and coopered the meet on the S
Lat 14.00 N. Long 170.27 East

Wednesday the last Day of March
This Day we have fine weather and
a light Breeze from the N. E. a Steering
W. by N. this Day we finished Coopering
Our meet and Loens this Day

Thursday the 1 of April
This Day we have fine weather and
Calm Saw 300 miles Loens and
Struck & saved 2 and histed them
in and hove them over Board a gane
tha was no oil thair 

Friday the 2 of April 1852
This Day we have fine weather and a
light Breeze from the N. E. a
Steering W. at 9 Saw a Island
The Name of it was the Wakes
at 12 the Captain and I
Went a Shore with the 4 men landed
Lat 19.15 N. Long 166.25 East

Saturday the 3 of April
We have fine weather and fine
Winds as yesterday a Steering N. W.
Lat 40.20 N. Long 166.06

Sunday the 4 of April 1852
This morning commences with fine
weather and a light Breeze from the
N. and E. a Steering N. W. by W. and
at 11 we had a thunder Squall and
at 1 fine weather calm and a heavy
Swell and so ends this Sunday B. F. J.

Monday the 5 of April
This Day we have calm and a heavy
Swell a Steering N. by W.
Loens this Day Belsey & Chapman
