This Day we left the Arctic Ocean for the  
Arctic Sea with a Strong Breeze from  
the N and E a Steering S S W  
the ice is all over the Ocean and No  
Whales there is 01 Ships in Sight  
Lat

Tuesday the 25 of May  
This Day ours commences with a heavy  
Gale of wind from the North and the  
with heavy Snow equals the weather  
cold and Blustering and so ends this Day

Wednesday the 26 of May  
This Day we have a Strong Breeze from  
the N and W a Steering into the  
S and E saw a number of Ships the  
Ship general Williams of New London  
with nothing an end so ends this Day  
Lat 58: 26 N Long 17: 16 E

Thursday the 27 of May  
This Day ours commences with a light  
Breeze from the S and W a Steering  
N W saw three fine dacks  
and so ends this Day Betty

Friday the 28 of May 1852  
This Day commences with a light  
Breeze from the S W and a thick fog  
a Steering N E and at 01 P M  
saw the Land and 2 Ships we on  
Bent the main topsail and put  
New points in it and bent it a  
gane later part a thick fog so ends

Saturday the 29 of May  
This Day commences with a thick fog  
at 01 the wind dlab on from  
N N E latter part from E  
at the land so ends this Day

Sunday the 30 of May 1852  
This Day commences with Rain and  
Hale and Snow we make no sail until  
4 o'clock P M and then we wore Ship  
the wind from the N E the Ship a  
heaving N W nothing in Sight  
and so ends this cold Sunday in this month

Munday the last Day of May 1852  
This Day commences with Snow and rain  
and fog so that we make no sail this  
Day we saw nothing this Day the  
Wind from the N and W dull weary  
Light and so ends the Day and Month  
No observations 3 Days Home Sweet Home

June the 1 — — — — 1852  
Tuesday this Day we have fine  
Weather and a light Breeze from  
the W a Steering N by E  
and so ends this 24 ours  
Lat 58: 56 N Long 172: 02 E

Wednesday the 2 of June  
This Day we have fine weather  
and a light breeze from the W a  
Steering N by E and we saw 4 Ships  
in Sight and so ends this 24 ours  
Lat 59: 51 N Long

Thursday the 3 of June  
This Day we have fine weather and  
plenty of ice and saw 15 Ships  
the wind from the W a running  
down a long the ice this Day ends  
Lat Long
