This Day we have fine weather and
a light Breeze from the N. a Steering
in to the N. with twenty or 30
Ships in Sight and 5 a Boiling
we think that the prospect is Better
and so ends this Day

Saturday the 5 of June
This Day we have fine weather and
a strong Breeze from the N. and
a Steering on the wind a long the ice
Backward and forward we saw 30
Ships and we spoke the Ship Columbia
and the Black Eagle of Sagharow
Lat 61:01 Long 1713:01

Sunday the 6 of June
This Day commences with thick fog
the middle part the fog lit up and
we saw a number of Ships and a
Plenty of ice latter part thick
fog and so ends this Day

Monday the 7 of June
This Day we have calm and a great
many ships in Sight and no whales
and so ends this 24 ours

Tuesday the 8 of June
This Day we have light winds
and foggy and a large Bobly
of ice in Sight this morning
latter part the fog lit up and
we saw a Boheals we loved all 4
Boats and Nathan Shuck
him and the iron Dredge and a
way he went that ends this Day

Wednesday the 9 of June 1852
This Day we have fine weather and a
fine Breeze and a great many ships
in Sight and 5 went thru the
Ice for the cap thabrus and so ends
Lat Long

Thursday the 10 of June
This Day commences with fine weather
the wind from the N. E. Ship a heaving
N. W. di N. and we went thru the
ice for cap thabrus and we saw 9 Boheals
and we loved 3 times this Day
Lat Long

Friday the 11 of June 1852
This morning we have a thick fog un-
til 01 and then the fog lit up a
Plenty of Ships in Sight one a Boiling
and 1 a cutting we have a strong down
from the S. a Steering N. by E.
the cap thabrus a Bout 3 miles off
and we saw a long side of the Columbia
and spoke him and there is 01 Ships in
Sight all Bound for the Arctic ocean
Lat 62 Long 179:01 &

Saturday the 12 of June
This Day we have a strong gale of wind
from the S. our Ship under close
Reef fore and mizen topsails and
Juddel reef main topsail a laying off
the cap thabrus we saw 5 Boheals

Sunday the 13 of June
This Day we have light winds from
the S. and the weather is thick and foggy
we saw whales loved our Boats 3
this Day and got nothing we saw
2 Ships a Cutting and 20 more the same
as our selves and so ends this Day
