and we finished Boiling and so ends

Sunday the 15 of August
This Day commences with a thick
fog and we took down 100 Barrels
of oil in the main hatch and
and so ends this Day

Monday the 16 of August
This Day we have thick and
Rainy weather No whales in sight

Tuesday the 17 of August
This Day commences with a gale of
wind and thick weather and
Rainy and Ship in sight so ends

Wednesday the 18 of August
This Day we have a gale of wind
from the N. our Ship under
Double Reef topsails and so ends

Thursday the 19 of August
This Day commences with a gale of wind
from the N. and we cleared our
Boon the latter part the weather
moderate and we made sail and heading
in to the S and E and so ends this

Friday the 20 of August
This Day we have fine weather and no
Whale saw a number of Ships and
their all bound for the Arctic to the North

on lineas on Board of the Ship "Win Tell" 1852

Saturday the 21 of August
This Day we have fine weather and a fine
Breeze from the S. a Steering N by E
to gain thro Barren Straits in to the
Arctic ocean and we bent a foresail and
fore topsail and so ends this Day
Lat Long

Sunday the 22 of August
This Day we have a Strong Breeze
from the S. E. a Steering N by E
and so ends these 24 ours

Monday the 23 of August
This 24 ours commences with a
Strong Breeze from the S. E. and
so ends these 24 ours

Tuesday the 24 of August
This Day we have fine weather
and no fish a number of Ships in
sight and none a whaling and so ends

Wednesday the 25 of August
This Day we have Strong Breezes
from the N and W saw a
number of Ships and a few whales
and so ends and we could not get
hold later part game in with
2 new Bel-ford Ships and so ends

Thursday the 26 of August
This Day commences with thick
fog and a Strong Breeze
and we saw a number of whales
about 30 Ships in sight the fog
let up and so ends this Day
