Sunday the 17 of April
This Day we havit Bad weather the wind
from the W we may sail and steer N by E
and at 10 last knight we had the hardest
gale of wind that we had since we have
ben out from home and it lasted a dunt
to ours the ship a sea and stove the
Bow Boat and washed the gangway over
Rail over Board but per more modret
Lat 43 N

Monday the 18 of April
This Day we havit more modret we
may sail and the wind from the W a
steering on the wind to the N the
weather cold and Snow Squalls we have
all kinds of weather and so on this Day
Lat 43:20 N Long 164:32 E

Tuesday the 19 of April 1853
This Day we hav a gail of wind from
the W and at 7 this morning we took
in sail and hove our ship too under
Close reef main topsail the fore part
heavy Squalls of Rain and wind latter
part the wind in Crest and no
Rain and this Day ends B.T.S

Wednesday the 20 of April
This Day we hav a hard gail from
the W our ship a heaving N by E
the weather is cold and Blustering
We Bloi our fore topmost Stasel
a way and Bent a new one
and we latoo thes 24 ours
and so on this Day

This Day we havit more modret and
we may sail and the wind from
the W our ship a heading N
on the wind and we took in the
Bow Boat to mend this Day is
Plesant for this part of the world
and so on this Day

Friday the 22 of April
This Day we havit more modret
the wind from the W a
steering N by E the
latter part the hald to the
W ship on the wind a heading N
the weather thick and Rany and
we coments a mending the Bow
Boat and so on this Day
Lat 46:38 N Long

Saturday the 23 of April
This Day we havit calm and
the milder part the wind from
the S W and our ship on his
Cours N by E the latter part
the weather thick with Snow
and Rain and this Day ends

Sunday the 24 of April
This morning we hav a Strong Bree
from the N W and at 2 P
the wind light we saw a Ship
and Spock hir and it was the
Skanais of mestic 7 months out
with 4 hummed Barrels of oil
and so on this Day
