Monday the 25 of April
This Day commences with a Strong Breeze
from the N^W & a Steering N^W by W
and at 10 we Dredged reeft our
top sails and at 3 we took in mizen
top sail and did the weather cold and
snow and ice and Loens this Day
Lat 49: 15 N Long 162: 59 E

Tuesday the 26 of April
This Day we have a Strong Breeze from
the N^W over Ship on the wind a heavy
W^W N^W the latter part the weather
More moderate the weather cold and some
snow and it freezes on Deck we have
to stir sharp to keep warm
and this cold Day ends B T S
Lat 50: 5 N Long

Wednesday the 27 of April
This Day commences with Calm and at 01 a
light Breeze from the S a Steering
N^W & latter part a thick Snow
Storm and cold the wind Strong from
the S and this Day Ends

Lat 51 N
Thursday the 28 of April
This morning we set the foresail and
shook out a Reef out of the main top sail
and at 10 took it in a gain and clost
Reeft the maintop sail a gale a heavy
gale from the S and at 4 we
Cald all hands to hoist up the mast
Boat and turn her up on her Gun
Over Ship roles and and pickles in
that we cant hardly get a
Boat

Friday the 29 of April 1853
This Day commences with a gale of wind from
the S^W and at 1 we cept off and
Steering N^W by N^W and at 4 we set
the foresail the wind not so hard last
night it Blew a heavy can
and this Day ends with cold weather
Lat 52: 3 N Long 164: 10 E

Saturday the 30 and the last Day of April
This Day we have fine weather and a light
Breeze from the W a Steering N^W by N^W
At 12 we saw the land ~~Sea~~ of Kam
Shatey and Copper island and Berings
Island ~~and~~ we saw a ship
at head and this Day ends and month
Lat 53: 53 N Long 165: 20 E

Sunday the 1 of May 1853
This Day we have a Strong Breeze from
the N^W a Steering N^W by E a
running a long down under the lee
of Berings island and Copper island
and at 11 we saw a right whale
and we loved our Boat but the weather
ther being so rugged that we could
ent do any thing with him
and Loens this Day ends
Lat 54: 36 N Long 168: 40 E

Monday the 2 of May
This Day we have the weather
thick and 4 Ships in sight and at 2
a thick Snow Storm Spoke Ship hamer
dal of new london and the Bark Alles
braver and we gamed with her and this
Day ends with a thick Snow Storm
to Berings
