

Continues on Board the Ship Wm Sell

Saturday the 28 of May 1863
This Day we have thick weather and a
Strong Breeze from the N and E
this Morning we Spent the Black
Eagle of Sag haddon and gamet all day
With 37 Ships in Sight we are near cap
thavous but we cant get no nearer than
30 miles for the Ice and this cold day ends
Lat N 50 E B Long

Sunday the 29 of May
This Day we have a Strong Breeze from
the N and E we air up to the Ice a
Lain with our main yard a Back first
on one tack and then on the other a
Waiting for the ice to Break up so that
we can get threw in to the heavy Sea
and we lored Down 3 Boats and pull
in to the ice but we saw no whale
But 36 Ships in Sight and so ends this

Monday the 30 of May
This Day comences with thick
weather and Snow and rain the
wind from the N and E a Strong
Breeze our Ship under Close Reef
Topsails our Rigger glass with
Ice latter part Saw 18 Ships
This Day ends with Cold and Rain
Lat N 50 E B Long

Tuesday the 31 of May ends
This Day we have thick and
Rany and Cold and a Strong
Breeze from the N and E our Ship
On the wind first on one tack
and then on the other under
Close Reef fore and main topsails
We saw one Bohead and 15 Ships
in Sight and this Day ends with
Lat N 50 E B Long

Wednesday the 1 of June 1863
This Day we have a Strong Breeze from
the N and E with the Land in Sight
and we saw one Bohead we air on the
wind first on one tack and then on the
other latter part Spent the Ship ontario
And gamet with her this Day ends
Lat N 50 E B Long

Thursday the 2 of June
This Day we have Snow and rain
and fog and a light Breeze from
the N and E and the ice in
Sight and the latter part gamet
with the Black Eagle and this Day ends
Lat N 50 E B Long

Friday the 3 of June
This Day we have fine weather and a
light Breeze from the N and E
a Beating thru the ice a trying
to get up to Capthavous
the land is 45 Miles distant
and there is 14 Ships in Sight
and there is Ice all around us and
this Day ends
Lat N 50 E B Long

Saturday the 4 of June
This Day we have fine weather and
Calm and we air in the ice and
at 02 we saw a Bohead and we
lored all our Boats our captain
was a gambling he aimed 2 to 5
he rather than whale gam the whale
Went in to the Ice there was 27
Ships in Sight one was a cutting
and one a doiblong and N and E
was a gunning we 16 Dues and 3
Sells and so ends this Day
