gam Sunday the 5 of June
This Day commences with fine weather
and we lowered our Bots and went in to
the Ice a Bout 8 Miles But we saw
nothing latter part a thick fog a
Calm the most of this Day the land in
sight and no whales. and so ends this
Lat 61: 40 N Long 178: 30 E

gam Monday the 6 of June
This Day we have all kinds of
weather fog and Rain latter part
clear a number of Ships in sight
and a plenty of Ice and this Day ends

Tuesday the 7 of June
This Day we have Sun fog and Sun
Clear weather with a plenty of Ice
and a plenty of Ships in sight the land
in sight we are all in a little ocean
that surrounded with Ice a waiting for a
Chance to get thru the ice up Bay
Cap Thoms But there is the ice
as thick as it can be
This Day ends with no whales

Wednesday the 8 of June
This Day we have a Strong Breeze
from the N and W our Ship
on the wind first on one tack
and then on the other middle part
a thick fog we lay with the main
yard a Back latter part Breeze from
aft and stood a long on the wind
to the S and W with 3 Ships
in sight no whales this Day
Ends No OB this Day

Thursday the 9 of June
This Day we have it thick the most
of this Day we saw a Bark and
our Captain went on Board and it was
the Ables of Coltspring and the
Black Eagle picked up a Dead whale
cut him in and the latter part gamed
a game with the ables a game
and this Day ends a gammen
No OB

Friday the 10 of June
This Day we have fine weather
a calm we saw the Mary
garbner of Lghardour and we
got Letters and we gamed with
his and with the Ontario of
Lghardour and this Day we saw
Whales at 11 o'clock at night so ends

Saturday the 11 of June
This Day we have a Strong Breeze
from the N and E and we saw
a number of whales and lowered our
Boats and we never let him a game
we saw a number of Ships a whaling
and only 1 took a whale and this Day
Cap Thoms in sight and a plenty of ice

Sunday the 12 of June
This Day we have fine weather and a
fine Breeze from the N E and we are
a Breeze up to Cap Thoms
and we got in and there was 15 Ships
in there and we cept of and run up
to the S E to Sea if we cant find
Sun whales and we saw a Ship a
Cutting and this Day ends
