Friday the 22 of July
This day comences with a thick fog
And Rain a light Bree from the S and
a Steering in to the N and E
with now thing in sight the
Day is Dark and the Time is a
going and No oil yet and so let it
go this Day Ends with No O B

Saturday the 23 of July 1853
This day comences with a thick fog and
Rain and we saw a ship but we did
not speak her the wind from the S E
and we kept on the wind to the E and
our crew got a futing and the captain
ser and galy a loft and the came
Down and the wood knot group a gain
and he put them in irons and put
them in the Run and this Day ends

Sunday the 24 of July
This morning the fog lit up and
we made sail and the wing hale
to the N and we Steered S W and
at 11 we saw 2 ships and we speak
one and it the ship Tiddy of Tiddy and
we Duded Recept our power and miven
topsails and kept too and lay with
the main yard a Back a thick fog and
Rain This morning the Captain tryed
to fit with our he Seas that i tryed
to mat Disturdant on Board of the
Ship and this Day Ends No O B

Monday the 25 of July
This day we have a thick fog the
Wind from the N and we air a
gamming with the ship worin of Tiddy
this Day ends

Tuesday the 26 of July
This morning we have a thick fog
and at 11 the fog lit up and the
land was in sight and it was a head
and the wing hale to the S and E and
we speak the ship Tushrig of Sag Mar
and gomed Cott 34.
