Saturday the 27 of August
This Day we have a fine Bree from the
N and W a Steering S E by E
This Day has past a way with fine weather
Lat 48:09 N Long 174:24 E

Sunday the 28 of August 1853
This Day commences with fine weather
and a light Bree from the W
a Steering S E by E this is the last
Sunday in this Month and Loends this Day
Lat Long

Monday the 29 of August
This Day we have a light Bree from
the S S E a Steering on the wind
a heaving & latter part the wind
rather stronger and Loends this Day
Lat 46:17 N Long 179:32 E

Tuesday the 30 of August
This Day we have a good Bree from
the S S E our ship a heaving &
and we mended our fore Sail and
Lobit in the Sail Room this Ends
Lat Long

Wednesday the 31 the last day of 1853
This Day we have it calm and we
Lent down the eleven top galentoad
and mended it and this Day ends

Thursday the 1 first of September
This Day we have a Strong Bree from
the N with a heavy head Beet Sea
a Steering S E by E and we Bent
the eleven top galent Sail and
this Day Ends
Lat Long 1853

Friday the 2 of September
This Day we have a light Bree from
the N W a Steering S E by E
The wind light thro this Day
Lat Long

Saturday the 3 of September
This Day commences with a light
Bree from the N a Steering
S E by E and at 3 the weather
thick and Rainy and Loends this
Lat Long

Sunday the 4 of September
This Day we have fine weather
and a fine Bree from the S W
a Steering S E by E this Day ends
Lat 42:01

Monday the 5 of September 1853
This Day we have fine weather and
a fine Bree from the S W and
the air a Steering S E by E and
we commenced a Rattlen Down our
Rigger and Loends this Day
Lat 40:30 Long 167:40
