gale in 2 ours and we saw them 5
Mils of and we lost 3 Bats but
we did not see them a gale
The Wind from the S W our Ship a
heaving S E By S this Day Ends

Lat 19° 41' S Long 154° 09' W
Monday the 5 of December
This Day commences with calm and
Ends the same and commences
Lat 20° 10' S Long 154° 48' W

Tuesday the 6 of December 1853
This Day we have the wind light
and Baffin latter part a light
Bree from the S and S and S ends

Wednesday the 7 of December
This Day commences with a fine Bree
from the S E a Steering S W by W
This morning we fitted a New Main
top sail and this Day Ends

Thursday the 8 of December
This Day we air of Mangroves
one of the Spirit Islands and
there was a Boat came from the
Shore and Boat Sam. Pinetops
the wind light and we air a
little to S and of the Island

Friday the 9 of December
This Day we air a kind of and on
to Mangroves a getting lunkers and
Pine Apples and Sweet potatoes
and Cakes and Onions and 1 hog

Saturday the 10 of December 1853
This Day we have a fine Bree from
the S E a Steering on the wind
to the S and this Day Ends
Lat 22° 30' S Long

Sunday the 11 of December
This Day we have fine weather
and a fine Bree from the
S and a Steering in to the
S and this Day Ends
Lat 25° 40' S Long

Monday the 12 of December
This Day we have a fine and fine
Weather a Steering S by E
and this Day Ends
Lat 28° 16' S Long 160° 22' W

Tuesday the 13 of December
This Day we have a Strong Bree
from the N E a Steering
S by E and this Day Ends
Lat 30° 3' S Long

Wednesday the 14 of December
This Day we have a Strong Bree
from the N E a Steering
S by E the weather thick
this Day ends
Lat 33° S Long

Thursday the 15 of December
This Day commences with thick weather
the wind from the N and we air
a Steering S by E and at 2 we
Dredge & Brought our topsails
Latter part the weather thick and
Rainy Ends this 24 ours
Lat 35° 00' S
