This Day we have good weather
and the wind from the N.W.
and we are steering N.W.
and we saw a number of fin backs
and hump backs and Loons this Day
Lat 58. 20. S Long 61. 05 W

Saturday the 28 of January
This morning we set the foresail
and it was set 1. our and it took
the hull watch to furl a gale
the wind blew a heavy cane
from the S and we lost the
Standard, quarter boat and the
lower topmast. Staysail and Sprit
our Main topsail this is the hardest
gale we have had since we have
been from home and this Day ends

Sunday the 29 of January
This Day we made sail we
on bent the Main topsail and
bent a new one the wind from
the S and we are a laying to wind
Der Cloes Reef Main topsail
and this Day ends

Monday the 30 of January the last
This Day we have all kinds of weather
This Day we made sail and at 10
we Dredged Reeft our top sails
latter part the wind light and
thick and rainy Loons this Day
Lat 56. 52 S Long 49. 20

Tuesday the last Day of January 1854
This Day we have thick smoky weather
and no whistles the wind from the
W our Ship on the and Loons

Wednesday the first of February 1854
This Day we have a light Breeze from
the W and Ship on the wind
and all of our carpenters to
work on the Davy and Loons

Thursday the 2 of February 1854
This Day commences with a thick
fog and at 11 commenced Raining
and Loons this Day

Friday the 3 of February
This Day we have good weather
and no fish the wind from the
S a Steady wind to the S
This Day ends
Lat 56. 18 Long 49. 00

Saturday the 4 of February
This Day we have the wind
from the S and W our Ship
on the wind a heaving to the
S and E and this Day ends

Sunday the 5 of February
This Day we have fine weather
and calm and at 6 we
saw a sail of our Standard
quarter and our Ship a heaving
to and this Day ends
Lat 29. 56 Long 49. 23

Monday the 6 of February
This Day we have variable weather
the wind from the N and W
our Ship a heading S W
the latter of this Day we
have a thunder and Rain
and we Dredged Reeft our
top sails and Loons this Day
