

Thursday the 16 of February 1854
This Day commences with a gale of wind
from the S W and we made Sail
and Steered N W latter part
the weather more Modest and
we saw a Ship and she was a
Steering & By S and this Day ends

Friday the 17 of February
This Day we have a Strong Breeze
from the N W and we are a
Steering S W and at 2 we
Budeki kept our topsails and
there was a Ship in sight of
our weather Bore and this Day ends
Lat 45: 24'

Saturday the 18 of February
This Day we have a light Breeze
from the S and W and our
Ship heads N and this Day ends
Lat 45: 8'

Sunday the 19 of February 1854
This morning we have a calm and
we saw several Whales and we
saw and we never saw them
out of the Boats and at 01 we
saw them from the Ship until
4 in the afternoon then the
wind heaved us up and this Day ends

Monday the 20 of February 1854
This Day we have a Strong Breeze
from the S W and we are a
Steering N E and this Day ends
Lat 45: 28' Long

Tuesday the 21 of February 1854
This Day we have a fine Breeze
from the N and W a Steering
N E and we closed our
Boats and this Day ends

Wednesday the 22 of February
This Day we have fine weather
and a fine Breeze from the
N E and we are a Steering
S E and we are all
hands Discreet and steady
of this voyage and this Day ends
Lat 44: 46 Long 55: 01

Thursday the 23 of February
This Day we have a Strong
Breeze from the S W a Steering
N E and we saw nothing
Shrew this Day and ends

Friday the 24 of February
This Day commences with a Rain
Storm the wind from the S W
and at twelve the wind heaved to
the E and our Ship heads W
This Day we got up topmast
Shrouds Sails Booms this Day ends

Saturday the 25 of February
This Day we have a fine Breeze
from the W a Steering
N E By E and this Day ends
Lat 39: 09 Long

Sunday the 26 of February 1854
This Day we have fine weather and
a fine Breeze from the W a Steering
N E By E and at 4 o'clock
the crew and served E of this Day ends
