air a Laving Down our Ruggin
and this Day has gone

Friday the 24 of March
This Day we have fine weather
and a fine Breeze from the S E
a Steering N N W 2 S ends

Saturday the 25 of March
This Day we have it Squally
and Rain the wind from the
N E a Steering N N W
and this Day ends into 18

Sunday the 26 of March
This Day we have it Squally and
the wind from the S E and we
air a Steering N N W
and we split our fly pit and
we fix a cross the Line in
the north lot and this ends
Lat 1 N Long

Tuesday the 28 of March 1854
This Day we have a Strong Breeze
from the N E and we air a Steering
N N W and this Day ends
Lat 2: 38 N

Wednesday the 29 of March
This Day we have the weather
more moist the wind from
the N E and we air a Steering
N N W this ends
Lat 4: 5 N Long 44: 13 1/2

Thursday the 29 of March 1854
This Day we have fine weather
and a fine Breeze from the N E
and we air a Steering N N W
and this Day ends
Lat 5: 56 N

Friday the 31 and the last
This Day we have fine weather
and a fine Breeze from the
N E a Steering N N W
and this Day ends
Lat 8: 41 N

Saturday the 1 of April
This Day we have fine Breeze
from the N E a Steering
N N W our work
is a most Sun and Breeze
Lat 11: 2 N

Sunday the 2 of April 1854
This Day commences with
heavy squalls of wind and
Rain and this Day ends
Lat 12 N Long 51: 04 1/2
