This Day we have Squalor and
Rain the wind from the S W a
Steering N W and we got no
done this Day ends

Monday the 17 of April 1854
This Day we have the wind from the
S and W on til 11 Then the wind
was light and Bafin all a round
The Campus and we tore our trivorks
down and cleaned the Brick and we
air in the gulf and we air 20. and
Miles from home and this Day ends
Lat 37:14 N Long 76:14

Tuesday the 18 of April 1854
This morning we had the wind from
the W a Steering N By W and
at 2 the wind came out N W
and at 4 we wore Ship and Dudd
Reeft fore and misen topsails
we cross the gulf Stream this morning
and this Day ends and we air 24
Lat 38:18 N

Wednesday the 19 of April 1854
This Day we have calm and at 2
we have a light Bree from the W
and our Ship a heading N By W
Lat 38:12 N

Thursday the 20 of April 1854
This Day we have a fine Bree
from the W a Steering N By W
latter part thick and Rainy
and at 7 we Landed and we
had 2.5 fathoms water

On Board of the Ship "Williana" sell
in April the 21 we arrived in to
Gardners Bay of a long voy of 31 and
one Day with 150 Barrels of oil
and this is the last of my
Whaling James M Sador
Master and James Oisten Chef
1 Mat and Silas E Shearman 2
Mat and Mr Brown 3 Mat
Nathan M Benet a Bot Steer
and William Lester a Bot Steer
and Henry Kelsey a Bot Steer
George a Bot Steer
