These 24 hours Commences with a light breeze heading to the S. & Westward the Watch Employed in rattling down the Fore & Gallant rigging & Stowing off between decks so ends these 24 hours,

Remarks Saturday Oct 20th 1855.

These 24 hours Commences with Moderate Trades Heading S. W. & S. W. by S. the Watch Employed in rattling down the Fore rigging. Saw Pin Barks. so ends these 24 hours,

Lat. 12-55 S.
Long. 26-16 W.

Remarks Sunday Oct 21st 1855.

These 24 hours Commences with Trades light & Squally Heading S. W. & S. by W. at 4 P. M. saw two Barks Standing to the S. Middle & latter part Strong Trades so ends these 24 hours.

Lat. 14-22 S.
Long. 26-37 W.

Remarks Monday Oct 22nd 1855.

These 24 hours Commences with Strong Trades & rugged & a heavy swell from the S. W. & S. by S. Under Whole Topsails Courses & Spanker Fore & Main Spencers. Middle part made some sail Latter shortened sail so ends these 24 hours,

Remarks Tuesday Oct 23rd 1855.

These 24 hours Commences with Strong Trades & rugged Heading S. the Watch Employed in painting the L. & W. Boats. Middle & latter part much the same so ends these 24 hours.

Remarks Wednesday Oct 24th 1855.

These 24 hours Commences with Moderate Trades Heading S. the Watch Employed in painting boats Under all sail latter part took in the Main & Gallant sail set up the Main Top Mast & Main & Gallant back Stays.

Lat. 19-36 S.
Long. 26-37 W.

Remarks Thursday Oct 25th 1855.

These 24 hours Commences with Moderate Trades Heading S. by S. the Watch Employed in sciring off the back Stays. so ends these 24 hours.

Lat. 20-48 S.
Long. 26-28 W.

Remarks Friday Oct 26th 1855.

These 24 hours Commences with light Trades Heading S. & S. by S. Bent the Main Top sail & bent the new one Middle & latter part much the same the Watch Employed in setting up the Main Top Mast rigging so ends these 24 hours.

Lat. 22-30 S.
Long. 26-10 W.
