looking for little Fish Bay at 6 P. M.
came to anchor in 7 fathoms of water.

& painting ship & sent up a new
main topmast.

Remarks Wednesday Feb. 27th 156.

Lying at anchor in little Fish Bay fitting
some rigging & painting some.

Lying at anchor in little Fish Bay got off
30 bushels of potatoes

Remarks Friday Feb. 29th 156.

Lying at anchor in little Fish Bay employed
in painting seams got off a Bullock
& killed it.
