Took in sail night Latter  
part rugged so ends.  
Lat. 13-28 N.  
Long. 8-30 E.

Remarks Friday March 7<sup>th</sup> 156.  
First part Strong breeze steering S. S. E. Under  
Lat. 12-53 S. Short sail Middle part Latter part  
Long. 08-49 E. Working off to the N.

Remarks Saturday March 8<sup>th</sup> 156.  
First part Good breeze working off to the N. Middle  
Lat. 11-39 S. part Under Short sail Latter part  
Long. 09-26 E. All sail out so ends.

Remarks Thursday March 20<sup>th</sup> 156.  
Much the same from March the 8<sup>th</sup> up to this  
date saw nothing at 10 A.M. saw  
the Bark Beris Capt. McFarlin  
taking a large Whale along side  
so ends.

Long. 07-30 E.

Remarks Wednesday April 16<sup>th</sup> 156.  
Saw nothing but Sperm & Fin backs from  
March 20<sup>th</sup> up to this date at 9 A.M.  
Came to anchor in St. Helena

Sailed from St. Helena Bound over on  
the Coast of Africa.
