First part Strong breeze steering E. N. E. Under
Short sail Middle part Latter part
Working off to the N.
Lat. 12-53 S.
Long. 08-49 E.

Remarks Saturday March 8th 156.
First part Good breeze Working off to the N. Middle
part Under Short sail Latter part
All sail out so ends.
Lat. 11-39 S.
Long. 09-26 E.

Remarks Thursday March 20th 156.
Much the same from March the 8th up to this
date saw nothing at 10 A.M. saw
the Bark Bevis Capt. McFarlin
taking a large Whale along side
so ends.
Lat. 08-14 S.
Long. 07-30 E.

Remarks Wednesday April 16th 156.
Saw nothing but Squid & fin backs from
March 20th up to this date at 9 A.M.
came to anchor in St. Helena

Sailed from St. Helena Bound over on
